

Megaride Espagne Pyrénées

♥ From Italy to the South of France all the way to Spain and back!

Lake Iseo, Piedmont, the French and Italian Alps, the Côte d'Azur, the Pyrenees, Andorra, the Tourmalet and l'Aubisque passes, the golf of Gascogne, the Gorges de l'Aveyron, the Millau viaduct, the Gorges du Verdon and more. This is on the program for the Espagne Pyrénée Megaride tour.



This two weeks tour will start in Lake Iseo, go through the hills and valleys of the Piedmont region, to reach Cuneo. From there we will ride through the French and Italian Alps, all the way to the Côte d'Azur and then follow the Mediterranean coast all the way the Pyrenees. From there we will go up to the Golf of Gascogne, and then on the way back, go through the Gorges du Verdon and more.


Our final destination will be our hotel in Lake Iseo.



The package includes a MégaVoyages representative who will meet you at the airport and transport you directly to the place where you take possession of your motorcycle. Most of our motorcycles are equipped with side cases and a top case. All motorcycles are equipped with GPS programmed with all the daily routes of your trip. Each morning, instructions will be given to you by the guide who will accompany you on your adventure.

Included in the package: economy class flights between Montreal and Venice, transportation between the hotel and the airport, all taxes and airport fees, motorcycle guide, 14 nights at the hotel, all dinners and breakfasts, motorbike rental with unlimited mileage, motorbike insurance, roadside assistance in Europe, a travel diary and souvenir gift from MégaVoyages. Contribution to the FICAV.

Excluded from the package: lunches, gas, tolls and personal expenses. Motorcycle riding equipment, helmets, etc. And any element not stated in the section "included in the package".

Day 1

Montreal – Venice

Departure from Montreal Trudeau airport around 20:00 arrival at Venice Marco Polo airport 10:00 local time.

Overnight flight with meals included.



Day 2

Venice, transfer by chartered bus to Lake Iseo

You will be met on arrival at the Venice Marco Polo airport, where you will board a bus to the hotel at Lake Iseo where you will take possession of your motorcycle. The motorcycles will already be prepared by the staff of MégaVoyages.

We relax and rest till dinner. There is nothing better than a stroll along the shore of lake Iseo, to stretch your legs or a swim in the hotel pool.



Day 3

Lake Iseo – Cuneo

The MégaVoyages team will start with a "hands on" activity to get you acquainted with riding in Italy and Europe. The format of this activity will be followed by a ride into the Lake Iseo region. All of that will be done without pressure, respecting everyone's rhythm, while still having fun. We will follow the roads of the Piedmont region, the hills of Monferrato, a region famous for its wines. Some of its vineyards are part of the World Heritage Fund (UNESCO).

Before dinner, if you want, you can enjoy a stroll through the town of Cuneo.



Day 4

Cuneo - Côte d'Azur

We leave Italy, direction France. We will be crossing the Italian and French Alps, ride through the famous Turini pass to finally reach the Mediterranean Sea and the Côte d'Azur. We will follow the coast all the way to our hotel.



Day 5

Côte d'Azur – Montpellier

On the agenda today is a ride through la Provence, the Mediterranean Sea coast, the route des Crêtes all the way to Montpellier.

If we get there early, a visit of the town is well worth a stroll, Montpellier is a beautiful city.



Day 6

Montpellier, France - Toses, Spain

From Montpellier we ride towards Spain, through valleys and hills, villages and medieval towns, between France and Spain. We will pass through the town of Carcassonne to get to our hotel in Toses, Spain.



Day 7

Toses, Andorra - Val d'Aran, Spain

Today we ride in the mountains in between Spain, France and Andorra, a small independent principality on the borders of France and Spain. If we feel like it, we may stop in a huge motorcycle accessories store and maybe a stop at a motorcycle museum. We will after that ride on beautiful mountain roads to get to our hotel Vielha in Catalonia.



Day 8

Val d'Aran, Spain - Lourdes, France

We leave the beautiful city of Vielha to again ride into the valleys and mountains in between Spain and France. We will cross the Tourmalet Pass to get to our hotel in the city of Lourdes. Lourdes greets 6 million visitors each year, who come to pray the Madonna. You will have time to visit the sanctuary and shop if you want.



Day 9

Lourdes – Hendaye

We leave Lourdes and again ride into the mountains, to cross the Soulor and Aubisque passes, St-Jean-Pied-de-Port to get to the French Basque country on the Atlantic coast.



Day 10

Hendaye - Albi

Today we leave the Atlantic coast to get to the center of France. Our route will take us along the coast and then turn towards our destination Albi, a small medieval village. Our hotel will be in the center of that beautiful village.



Day 11

Albi – Anduze

We will leave the medieval village of Albi to reach the Viaduct of Millau. Our route will take us through the Gorges de l'Aveyron to finally reach our hotel in Anduze.



Day 12

Anduze - La Provence

Again, today we ride curvy roads, through the Gorges de l'Ardèche, all the way to Baux-de-Provence, one of the most beautiful village of France. It's another busy place that gets over a million visitors per year.



Day 13

La Provence - Susa, Italy

Leaving la Provence for Italy, we pass through the Gorges du Verdon. We then will cross the French and Italian Alps to reach the town of Susa.



Day 14

Relax Day – Susa

Today is a relax day. If you wish, you can follow the guide into the Alps either on the Italian or the French side. Maybe do the Isoard pass or the Madeleine, the Mont Cenis and Iserand passes. Or you could relax and visit the beautiful Roman city of Susa.



Day 15

Susa - Lake Iseo Italy

We leave Susa, direction Lake Iseo. Our route will take us through Val Brembana and Val Seriana, then along Lake Iseo to our hotel. At dinner we will announce the time the bus will leave for the airport in the morning.



Day 16

Venice, Montreal, home

The bus will transport you to Venice Marco Polo airport. Your direct flight to Montreal, with Air Transat departs at 13:00. Arrival should be at about 16:00 local time.

Meals will be served during the flight.



Note:

The itineraries and routes chosen for our Megarides have been prepared according to currently known conditions. Although the chosen period is ideal for our Megaride your guide may change or adjust the routes for reasons out of MégaVoyages' control due to amongst other, bad weather or impassable roads.

Included in the package:

- Return flight Montréal – Venice with Air Transat, direct.
- International Airport taxes.
- All taxes and services
- A guide accompanying the group for the whole stay.
- 14 nights in 4- and 3- stars hotels typical to the region visited.
- 14 dinners typical of the region visited composed of many services and including 0,20 l of wine, 1/2 l of water, dessert and coffee or cappuccino.

- One sport touring type motorcycle per rider (pilot), according to the client's choice and availability at the time of the reservation.
- Most motorcycles have side cases, a topcase, GPS, disabling alarms, are comfortable and recent.

- Motorcycle comprehensive insurance
- (A 2900 € deductible in case of accident at fault or without identified third party and theft.).
- The deductible may be reduced.
- Roadside assistance all over Europe
- Unlimited kilometers
- Transportation between the Airport and the hotel.
- A MégaVoyages gift.
- A roadbook including good to know information, the itinerary, hotel addresses and group ride rules.

Not included in the package:

- Gasoline, tolls, and personal expenses.
- Lunches
- Motorcycling equipment, jacket, helmet, gloves.
- Tips and other gratuities.
- Any element not specified in the section « Included in the package »

Deposit and balance due

Early booking deposit: an amount of \$ 300, applicable to the 1st deposit if made before October 1st preceding the tour. It gives you priority in the room bookings and sets the price of the chosen tour. This amount is not refundable.

1st deposit: a deposit of \$2000 per rider or \$1000 per passenger is required and must be paid at registration time or before October 1st preceding the tour. This amount is not refundable.

Balance due: 60 days before the tour. This amount is not refundable.

Checks are payable to MégaVoyages Inc. and will be deposited into a trust account as requested by Quebec Consumer protection law. Québec license number 703316

Cancellation

In case of cancellation by a participant:

- from the reservation to 91 days before departure: \$2,000.00 for the rider, \$1,000.00 passenger
- from 90 days to 61 days before departure: \$2,500.00 for the rider, \$1,500.00 passenger
- from 60 days to a day before departure: 100 % of the tour price, including all taxes

Departure day is not included in the cancellation delay.

The travel cancellation insurance is not refundable.

We reserve the right, if circumstances require it, to change the itineraries and the sequence order of our programs.

Prices take into account the following parameters:

- transportation cost taking into account fuel and exchange rates.
- all fees and taxes such as local airport taxes, airport usage and improvement fees, in ports and airports.
- the relevant currencies exchange rate.

According to the Quebec Consumer Protection Office (OPC) regulation, the price may be increased up to thirty (30) days before departure date if due to some major circumstances, the condition above would change.

If the cost of the tour increases at least 7% (excluding taxes), the customer may cancel and be reimbursed. He may accept another tour as a replacement.
