

Megaride Méditerranée

♥ A dream moto journey! Rome, Sardinia, Corsica, Gorges du Verdon, Côte d'Azur, French and Italian Alps, the hills of Montferrat and Lake Iseo.

Here is a summary of the motorcycle tour Megaride Méditerranée. We start our journey around Rome and then in the evening we will board an overnight ferry in the port of Civitavecchia to travel overnight to Sardinia where we will spend 3 nights and 4 days riding in the wild nature of the island.

On the fourth day, we will travel to Santa Teresa di Gallura to board a ferry to Corsica, the Island of Beauty. There we will stay 4 nights and 5 days exploring the Island.



Again, we will board an overnight ferry in Bastia to reach Toulon in France. From there our route will take us through the Gorges du Verdon, then the Riviera Ligure and the Italian Alps.

We may either travel along the French Riviera, the Côte d'Azur, or the French Maritime Alps to then reach Cuneo in the Piedmont region of Italy. Our last day will take us to Lake Iseo.



The package includes: a representative of MégaVoyages will meet your group at the airport and will ensure your transportation to the base hotel where you will pick up your motorcycle. Most of our motorcycles are equipped with side and top cases. All our motorcycles are equipped with a GPS preprogrammed with all the relevant itineraries. Each morning, instructions will be given by your accompanying guide during your adventure.

This Megaride is available in Spring and Fall.

Options available

- Airline Tickets for international flights
- Car rental before or after the tour
- Travel insurance medical and or cancellation

Included in the package: transportation from the airport to the base hotel, a moto guide, 12 nights' accommodations, 2 nights on board a ferry, all dinners, all breakfasts, motorcycle rental with unlimited kilometers, motorcycle insurance, road assistance in Europe, tour book, a MégaVoyages souvenir gift.

Excluded from the package: Airline Tickets, lunches, fuel, highway and parkway tolls, personal expenses and personal motorcycle protection gear, helmets, etc. and the contribution to the FICAV. Anything not specified in the included in package section.

Day 1

Montreal – Rome

If you have purchased your tickets from MégaVoyages, departure from Montreal Trudeau airport around 20:00 arrival at Rome Fiumicino airport 10:00 local time.

Overnight flight with meals included.



Day 2

Rome, private shuttle to our hotel

Meet the group at Fiumicino airport in Rome, after passing through customs, you will be met by a representative, the transit to our 4* hotel will be done by shuttle where we will take possession of our motorcycles. All the bikes will have been prepared, ready to roll. After the paperwork, you are free to use the hotel facilities, go for a nap or a stroll around the grounds. Take it easy, you're on vacation.



Day 3

Rome, Civitavecchia, Sardinia, Cagliari

The day will start with a hands-on activity where we will introduce you to riding in Italy. We will ride around Rome until the evening when we reach the port of Civitavecchia and board our overnight ferry. Diner and a night stay on board.



Day 4

Cagliari, Golfo degli aranci, Sardinia

The ferry will arrive early in the morning in Sardinia. Breakfast will be served on board before disembarking. We have all day to cross the Island. Our route will take us through the hills of central Sardinia, to reach the Golfo degli aranci on the Costa Smeralda (Emerald Coast).



Day 5

Sardinia – Relax day

This is a relax day and we are staying in the same hotel from where we can explore the island. Each day we can ride in a different area or as always, many itineraries will be preloaded on the GPS.



Day 6

Sardinia – Relax day

Another relax day at our 4 stars hotel in Sardinia. You can ride, follow your guide, or stay at the hotel, enjoy the pool or the private beach. Our MégaVoyages guide will ride. Follow him if you wish, he will show you different sides of the island.



Day 7

Sardinia - Corsica - Zonza

This is our last day in Sardinia. We will travel to Corsica but first we must reach Santa Teresa di Gallura to board a ferry to Corsica. Our stop for the night is Zonza, located in the middle of the island.



Day 8

Zonza, Corsica – relax day

Relaxed day, so as always, your MégaVoyages guide will prepare different itineraries for you which will be loaded onto the GPS.

Or if you feel like it, you can visit beautiful little picturesque Corsican villages!

Dinner at Zonza in a restaurant near the hotel.



Day 9

Zonza, Corsica, Bastia

Today, we are heading towards the north of Corsica, we will drive on mountain roads, each one more winding than the last, and as a bonus along the Mediterranean to get to Bastia.

A lovely little dinner by the sea and dinner in Bastia.



Day 10

Corsica - Relax day

It's another relax day in Corsica. The MégaVoyages guides have plenty of itineraries that they can suggest if you want to explore on your own or you can follow him. It's up to you to enjoy your tour the way you want.



Day 11

Bastia, Corsica – Bastia, Corsica - Ferry

This is our last day in Corsica, enjoy the routes along the coast. Our destination is Bastia where we will board an overnight ferry to Toulon France.

Diner will be served on board.



Day 12

Toulon, France – Gorges du Verdon, Vallée Nervia

We get up early, have a quick breakfast before the ship arrives in Toulon. We will then head to the Gorges du Verdon. The routes along the Gorges follow along the top of the cliffs along the river. Next, destination Nervia in Italy.

Nervia Valley – Relax Day

This is another relax day where you can visit ancient medieval towns, stroll on the Côte d’Azur or ride to the French Maritime Alps and the Col de Turini.

14**

Nervia Valley -Riviera Ligure, Cuneo

The ride today starts on the seacoast then we will cross mountain passes to reach Cuneo in the Piedmont. We want to get there early as there is good food and good wine in that area. There is also lots of shopping opportunities under the city’s arcades.

15**

Cuneo - Lake Iseo

Yes, it's almost over! We leave the area riding through the Piedmont region, the hills of Montferrat, a region that is part of the UNESCO World Heritage. Our goal for the day is to return to our hotel at lake Iseo where we will return the bikes.

16**

Venice - Montreal, home

For those that have purchased their airline tickets from MégaVoyages, transportation will be provided by MégaVoyages to Venice airport. Departure time will be announced. Our flight from Venice to Montreal by Air Transat leaves approximately at 13:00 and arrives in Montreal around 16:00.

Meals will be served on board.



Note :

The itineraries and routes chosen for our Megarides have been prepared according to currently known conditions. Although the chosen period is ideal for our Megaride your guide may change or adjust the routes for reasons out of MégaVoyages’ control due to amongst other, bad weather or impassable roads.

Option(s) available

- Airline tickets for international flights
- Car rental before or after the tour
- Travel insurance medical and or cancellation

Included in the package:

- 12 nights in 4 and 3 * hotels typical to the region visited.
- 2 nights on board the ship
- 12 dinners typical of the region visited composed of many services and including 0,20 l of wine, 1/2 l of water, dessert and coffee or cappuccino.
- 2 dinners on board the ship, at his restaurant with many services, desserts and coffee included.
- All breakfasts
- All taxes and services
- A guide accompanying the group for the whole stay.
- One grand touring type motorcycle per rider (pilot), according to the client's choice and availability at the time of the reservation.
- All motorcycles have side cases, some have a topcase.
- Each motorcycle is equipped with a GPS, some have disabling alarms, a safety vest and a first-aid kit.
- Comprehensive insurance for the motorcycle and its passengers.
- Motorcycle comprehensive insurance (A 2900 € deductible in case of accident at fault or without identified third party and theft.).
- The deductible may be reduced.
- Roadside assistance all over Europe
- Unlimited kilometers.
- Transportation by chartered bus from the Airport to the Hotel, and return to the airport at the end of the tour
- A souvenir Megarides
- Tour book

Not included in the package:

- Lunches
- Gasoline, tolls, local ferries, your International Drivers Permit and personal expenses.
- Airline Tickets for international flights
- Tips and other gratuities.
- Contribution to the Fonds d'indemnisation des clients des agents de voyages (FICAV).
- Motorcycling equipment, jacket, helmet, gloves.
- Any element not specified in the section « Included in the package ».

All-risk insurance does not cover:

- All bodily injury and material damage while using the vehicle on unpaved roads (off-road prohibited)
- The cost of repairing or replacing the tire(s) in the event of a puncture
- Compensation for luggage transported in and on the motorcycle during a theft or accident
- Transport costs to the planned drop-off point of the motorcycle if the lessee cannot bring it back himself.
- Administration fees of \$25 in addition to the deductible.

Traffic violations:

Traffic violations (fines) are at the renter's expense.

In the event of a violation served by a competent authority, an administration fee of \$50 +tx per violation will be added.

DEPOSIT AND BALANCE DUE

Early booking deposit: an amount of \$ 300, applicable to the 1st deposit if made before October 1st preceding the tour. It sets your priority in the room bookings and sets the price of the chosen tour. This amount is not refundable.

1st deposit: a deposit of \$2000 per rider or \$1000 per passenger is required and must be paid at registration time or before October 1st preceding the tour. This amount is not refundable.

Balance due: 60 days before the tour. This amount is not refundable.

Checks are payable to MégaVoyages Inc. and will be deposited into a trust account as requested by Quebec Consumer protection law. Permis du Québec No 703316

Cancellation

In case of cancellation by a participant:

- from the reservation to 91 days before departure: \$2,000.00 for the rider, \$1,000.00 passenger
- from 90 days to 61 days before departure: \$2,500.00 for the rider, \$1,500.00 passenger
- from 60 days to a day before departure: 100 % of the tour price, including all taxes

Departure day is not included in the cancellation delay.

The travel cancellation insurance is not refundable.

We reserve the right, if circumstances require it, to change the itineraries and the sequence order of our programs.

Prices take into account the following parameters:

- transportation cost taking into account fuel and exchange rates.
- all fees and taxes such as local airport taxes, airport usage and improvement fees, in ports and airports.
- the relevant currencies exchange rate.

According to the Quebec Consumer Protection Office (OPC) regulation, the price may be increased up to thirty (30) days before departure date if due to some major circumstances, the condition above would change.

If the cost of the tour increases at least 7% (excluding taxes), the customer may cancel and be reimbursed. He may accept another tour as a replacement.
