

Megaride Tour de l'Adriatique

♥ Slovenia – Croatia – Italy, on a bike. A dream motorcycle journey around the Adriatic, starting in the alpine lakes region of Italy, the Julian Alps, then Croatia, Slovenia, the Apennines, San Marino, and return to Lake Iseo.

Here is a summary of the program for the Megaride Tour de l'Adriatique.

Our tour starts from Lake Iseo in the direction of the Italian Alps. We will first travel through Trentino-Alto Adige, where we will stay for 2 nights, Friuli-Venezia Giulia and then, after a stop in the city of Udine, we will ride into Slovenia and all the way to Zagreb, the capital of Croatia, a beautiful city full of shops and restaurants.



The package includes: a representative of MégaVoyages will meet your group at the airport and will ensure your transportation to the base hotel where you will pick up your motorcycle. Most of our motorcycles are equipped with side and top cases. All our motorcycles are equipped with a GPS preprogrammed with all the relevant itineraries. Each morning, instructions will be given by your accompanying guide during your adventure.

Option(s) available

- International Airline tickets.
- Car rental, before or after the tour.
- Travel Insurance (medical/tour cancellation) Manulife or Blue Cross

Included in the package : Transport between the hotel and the airport, a moto guide, 13 nights in 3* and 4* hotels , 11 dinners, all breakfasts, 1 night in cabin on the ferry with a multi-services dinner, 2 ferries, 1 between Split/Starigrad and 1 between Sucuraj/Drvenik, motorcycle rental with unlimited kilometers, motorcycle insurance, road assistance in Europe, tour book, a MégaVoyages souvenir gift and the contribution to the FICAV. Also included, the city taxes, all taxes and services.

Excluded from the package: Airline tickets, lunches, dinners in Zagreb and Dubrovnik, fuel, road tolls and your personal expenses. Personal motorcycle protection gear, helmets, etc. And anything not specified in the included in package section.



From Zagreb we head to Poreč, where we will have a day to explore the region of Istria. Afterwards, we head to Zadar on the Dalmatian coast. We take a ferry to the island of Hvar; an island often nicknamed the Dalmatian "Saint-Tropez". Another ferry will take us to Dubrovnik, a fascinating medieval city nicknamed the pearl of the Adriatic. A third ferry, a longer crossing this time, will take us across to Ancona, Italy, where we will ride through the Marche and Umbria regions to get to Perugia. We continue our journey through the valleys and hills of the Apennines to arrive in the Republic of St. Marin, to end the next day at Lake Iseo.

Day 1

Montreal – Venice or Milan

Departure from Montreal via Air Transat at approximately 20:00, arrival in Venice at approximately 13:00 local time. Please check ahead to confirm departure time.

Meals will be served on board.



Day 2

Milan or Venice, transfer to Lake Iseo

You will be met upon your arrival at Venice airport by a representative from MégaVoyages and then travel by chartered bus to our 4 stars hotel in Lake Iseo.

Your bikes will be waiting for you at the hotel, ready to accept your luggage for tomorrow's (Sunday) departure.

R & R We relax and rest till dinner. There is nothing better than a stroll along the shore of lake Iseo, to stretch your legs or a swim in the hotel pool.



Day 3

Lake Iseo, Levico Terme, Trentino-Alto-Adige

On this first riding day of the tour, our first destination is Lake Garda. Our route will meander through valleys and lower mountain passes in the Lake Garda region and then Levico Terme in the Trentino-Alto-Adige.



Day 4

Levico Terme, Trentino-Alto-Adige, relax day

It is a relax day for everyone. You can stay at the hotel or visit nearby villages or explore with your guide the curvy roads of the Trentino-Alto-Adige.

Why not a stroll along lake Levico or visit a vineyard?



Day 5

Levico Terme, Udine, Friuli-Venezia Giulia

On this day, the group will ride through the mountains of Trentino-Alto-Adige and Friuli-Venezia Giulia to get to the city of Udine, not far from the Slovenia border.



Day 6

Udine, Italia, Zagreb, Croatia

Today, the tour will start from Udine in Italy, cross into Slovenia to reach the city of Zagreb in Croatia. Zagreb the capital of Croatia, is characterized by its Austro-Hungarian architecture from the 18th and 19th centuries. Dinner is not included; you are free to enjoy the many restaurants of this beautiful city.



Day 7

Zagreb, Poreč, Croatia

Today, from the city of Zagreb, we head north along the Adriatic Sea to Poreč in Croatia or Parenzo in Italian, a town and municipality located in Istria, Istria County, Croatia.

We will stay 2 nights; buses will take you to the summit of a hill for a taste of typical Croatian dishes.



Day 8

Poreč, Croatia, relax day

This is a relax day, if you wish to visit the region, your moto guide will take you on the roads of Istria. If you wish to visit the beautiful towns and villages of the Istria region, you are free to do so or enjoy the beach on the Adriatic Sea. Tonight, buses will take you to a Croatian Konoba for a typical Croatian dinner and local wines.



Day 9

Poreč, Croatia, Zadar

Our beautiful adventure will take us along the Adriatic Sea, on the Dalmatian Coast in the direction of Zadar. This city is known for its old Roman and Venetian ruins, the richness of its heritage and its incredible nocturnal life.



Day 10

Zadar, Croatia, island of Hvar

We are riding to an island. Yes, ladies and gentlemen. A ferry will take us the island of Hvar. It is one of the most beautiful islands of Croatia, with spectacular views, a rich heritage and a great nightlife.



Day 11

Island of Hvar, Croatia, Dubrovnik

From our hotel on the Island of Hvar, on this day we will cross to the other side to take a ferry for Dubrovnik, a city situated in the south of Croatia. It's a city famous for its high stone walls dating back to the XVI century.

Dinner is not included; you are free to enjoy the many restaurants of this beautiful city.



Day 12

Dubrovnik, Croatia, Split

Our tour is now heading back north, direction the city of Split where we will embark on a ferry to cross the Adriatic Sea over to Italy. Split is a coastal city with beautiful beaches and a complex akin to a fortress in its centre. This is the palace of Diocletian, the IV century Roman Emperor.



Day 13

Split, Croatia, Perugia, Italy

Our crossing of the Adriatic Sea will get us to Ancona in Italy. Our route will take us through Umbria and the Marches until we eventually reach Perugia

Perugia is an Italian city, the capital of Umbria. It is known for its historic center surrounded by high walls.



Day 14

Perugia, Italy, San Marino

We leave the city of Perugia at destination of San Marino.

San Marino is a mountainous microstate landlocked in north-central Italy. As one of the oldest republics in the world, it has retained much of its historic architecture.



Day 15

San Marino, Lake Iseo

It's almost over.

On the program today is a bit of autoroutes between San Marino and our hotel at Lake Iseo.

On this day we return the bikes and equipment and get ready for our last meal.



Day 16

Milan or Venice, Montréal

The MégaVoyages bus will take the group to the airport. The airport will be either Milan or Venice depending on which one the group flies out of.

The departure time will be announced at the last dinner on Friday night.



Note :

The itineraries and routes chosen for our Megarides have been prepared according to currently known conditions. Although the chosen period is ideal for our Megaride your guide may change or adjust the routes for reasons out of MégaVoyages' control due to amongst other, bad weather or impassable roads.

Option(s) available

- International Airline tickets
- Car rental, before or after the tour
- Travel Insurance (medical/tour cancellation) Manulife or Blue Cross

Included in the package:

- 13 nights in 4 and 3 * hotels typical to the region visited.
- 1 night on board the ship between Split and Ancona.
- 11 dinners typical of the region visited composed of many services and including 0,20 l of wine, 1/2 l of water, dessert and coffee or cappuccino.
- 1 dinner on board the ship, at his restaurant with many services, desserts and coffee included.
- All breakfasts.
- All taxes and services fees.
- The buses for the typical dinners in Poreč.
- The ferries for the island Hvar between Split/Starigrad and between Sucuraj/Drvenik.
- A guide accompanying the group during the whole stay.
- One grand touring type motorcycle per rider (pilot), according to the client's choice and availability at the time of the reservation.
- All motorcycles have side cases, some have a top case.
- Each motorcycle is equipped with a GPS, some have disabling alarms, a safety vest and a first-aid kit.
- Motorcycle comprehensive insurance (A 2900 € deductible in case of accident at fault or without identified third party and theft.).
- The deductible may be reduced.
- Roadside assistance all over Europe
- Unlimited kilometers.
- Transportation by chartered bus from the Airport to the Hotel and return to the airport at the end of the tour.
- A souvenir from Megaride MégaVoyages.
- The contribution to the FICAV (Fond d'indemnisation des clients des agences de voyage du Québec).
- A Megaride tour book including travel information, the itinerary and the regions visited.

Not included in the package:

- Lunches
- Gasoline, tolls, local ferries, your International Drivers Permit and personal expenses.
- Tips and other gratuities.
- Motorcycling equipment, jacket, helmet, gloves.
- International flight tickets.
- Dinners in Zagreb and Dubrovnik
- Any element not specified in the section « Included in the package ».

The insurance does not cover:

- Injuries or damages while using the rented vehicle while on unpaved roads (off-road forbidden)
- Repairs or replacement of tires in case of a flat.
- Loss of luggage on the motorcycle due to theft or collision.
- Transportation fees to bring the motorcycle to the expected drop-off point in case the lessee can't return it himself.
- Administration fees above the franchise.

Traffic tickets and other offenses to the highway code:

- All traffic offenses (tickets) are the responsibility of the vehicle lessee. In case of a traffic citation signified by the authorities, an administration fee of \$50 per offense will be added.

DEPOSIT AND BALANCE DUE

- **Early booking deposit:** an amount of \$ 300, applicable to the 1st deposit if made before October 1st preceding the tour. It sets your priority in the room bookings and sets the price of the chosen tour. This amount is not refundable.
- **1st deposit:** a deposit of \$2000 per rider or \$1000 per passenger is required and must be paid at registration time or before October 1st preceding the tour. This amount is not refundable.
- **Balance due:** 60 days before the tour. This amount is not refundable.
- Checks are payable to MégaVoyages Inc. and will be deposited into a trust account as requested by Quebec Consumer protection law. Permis du Québec No 703316

Cancellation

In case of cancellation by a participant:

- from the reservation to 91 days before departure: \$2,000.00 for the rider, \$1,000.00 passenger
- from 90 days to 61 days before departure: \$2,500.00 for the rider, \$1,500.00 passenger
- from 60 days to a day before departure: 100 % of the tour price, including all taxes

Departure day is not included in the cancellation delay.

The travel cancellation insurance is not refundable.

We reserve the right, if circumstances require it, to change the itineraries and the sequence order of our programs.

Prices take into account the following parameters:

- transportation cost taking into account fuel and exchange rates.
- all fees and taxes such as local airport taxes, airport usage and improvement fees, in ports and airports.
- the relevant currencies exchange rate.

According to the Quebec Consumer Protection Office (OPC) regulation, the price may be increased up to thirty (30) days before departure date if due to some major circumstances, the condition above would change.

If the cost of the tour increases of at least 7% (excluding taxes), the customer may cancel and be reimbursed. He may accept another tour as a replacement.
